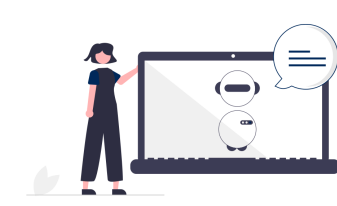

### L&T in the news



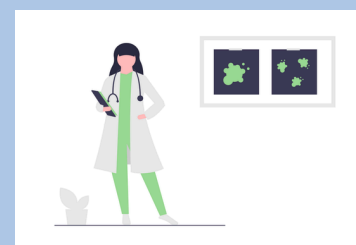
Forget about teaching assistants and meet Julian. [Julian is an artificial intelligence](#) (FR) experimented at Walden University. His role consists in absorbing content given by teachers/lectures and generating random evaluations from it. Aligned with recent discussion about [the future of education in a metaworld](#) (FR), such an approach illustrates an early advantage brought by IA into education (new experience, gaining time). Needless to say, the increasing use of cloud computing in education (tools, social network, IoT) continues to trigger a deeper reflection on the role of [ethics applied to the digital](#) world (FR).

Behaviors, values change from a generation to another and when the youngest stop reading, some professors step up efforts to make [flipped classrooms work](#) (EN). Others argue that pedagogy should go further and adapt completely to how the new generations consume digital content: and to develop [snack content](#) (FR). Maybe without generalizing this pedagogical approach, it is true that students suffered from attending remote classes during a long period, things can be improved for [preserving mental health](#) (EN). As Audencia is working on the distance-learning semester for the PGE, we closely examined [students' feedback on their experience](#) of distance learning (EN). We also found some tips on [making engaging videos](#) (FR).

At a more macro level, wider stakes appear for the [Education sector related to the role of IT](#) in 2022 (EN), bearing in mind that student's motivation must be our priority in order to avoid [dropouts](#) (EN). It is also appropriate to consider seriously the weight of emotions in daily work when our graduates will get their jobs or internship, and [produce teaching materials embedding human and psychological issues](#) (EN) into business cases so as to build a more humanistic vision of the workplace. Finally, Paul Leblanc, the president of Southern New Hampshire University, wonders how competences are located within diplomas and promotes a [competence-based education](#) (EN) where hidden skills are revealed and recognized: a topic closely linked to Audencia's C4I project.

### L&T in research

Slow down during your holidays and take time to come back to [pedagogical fundamentals during this webinar](#) (FR) facilitated by Stephanie Demers, from Quebec University. Discover also how 5 professors and 2 learning designers changed their approach and methods while building up together a [cross-disciplinary training](#) (FR).



With current changes to the teaching modalities, a [focus on hybrid learning strategies](#) (FR) is not surprising, as well as questioning the [relevance of the given resources](#) (FR). These reflexive feedbacks are necessary to fight against what could trigger [mental health disorder among students](#) (EN) during distance learning.
